



TOXLINE® Special Advanced Search


TOXLINE® Special is an extensive bibliographic database for toxicology, providing information covering the biochemical, pharmacological, physiological, and toxicological effects of drugs and other chemicals. In this tutorial, we will look at how to search the product using several advanced features, including field-specific searching and searching by date range.




The TOXLINE Special Advanced search tool is available near the top of your screen. Click the dropdown icon to view all Search functions.




Click on the Advanced tab, then select TOXLINE Special Advanced. This brings up a search box which allows you to conduct field specific searching. The Search Field dropdown allows you to search by Title, Abstract, Authors, or All fields. Also present is a Publication Year box allowing you to select a specific date range within which to search.



Select the field you would like to search and enter the desired criteria in the corresponding search boxes. (for example, *lead* in the Title field and Publication Year from 2010 to 2018). Click the Submit button to execute the search.




Note that by using Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT), you can adjust your searches to be even more specific (for example, *lead* AND *arsenic* in the Title field).




After conducting a search, a tabular list of documents is retrieved. In this example, the list includes all documents that contain *lead* in their title and that have a publication year between 2010 and 2018, inclusive. In addition to Title, this display also provides Author(s), Source, Publication Year, and Collection information. Results can be sorted in either ascending or descending order by clicking on the corresponding field headings.








You can navigate the results pages using either the paging arrows or the "Go To Page" box.



You can print results by using either the Print Current Page or Print All Results. From the print window, you will also can save these results as a PDF. To access the Print Settings menu, click on the gear icon next to the printer icons.





Select the Title for which you would like to see more information.



The document opens in a new window. You can navigate using the Menu on the left-hand side of the screen.





You can print the document using your browser's "Print" function, or you can generate and print or save a PDF by clicking the orange PDF icon in the Navigation Menu.
